

Theatre Merit Scholarship Application 2023/24

- 1. Applicant must be a current FSPA student:
 - Enrolled in an FSPA Theatre Class
 - Have completed previous full term of FSPA Theatre Classes
 - Tuition must be paid in full for **previous term** to be eligible to audition
- 2. Complete and return the application to the FSPA Office, mail the application to: 1025 E. Kearsley St., Flint, MI 48503 (if mailing put attention David Kassel) or email the application to: dikassel@thefim.org.

Applications must be received (postmarked) by 5:00 PM on Friday, January 5, 2024, no exceptions.

3. Applications must be turned in by the applicant. Applications submitted by an instructor will not be accepted.

- 4. Applicants must complete an audition consisting of a prepared monologue from a published play between one and two minutes in length. The monologue being performed must be memorized. If you have previously performed a monologue that was awarded a scholarship, **you must select a new monologue**. Your audition starts once you walk into the audition room and have been introduced to the Adjudicators. **The adjudicators may interrupt your monologue at any point in time.**
- 5. Scholarship awards are determined solely by the adjudicators at the time of the audition. Awards range from 60% 80% of tuition for one semester or two terms of theatre classes in the upcoming semester. Awards for nine-week classes will be split between both terms.
- 6. Please actively monitor the e-mail address you provided on your application, as all communications surrounding auditions and scholarship awards will be sent by e-mail.
