All skill levels are welcome!



Dance Makers • Ages 2 - 4 (with Parent or Caregiver)



Adult Classes

Adult Ballet I, II, III & Adult Modern • Ages 14 - Adult

Whether you are a beginner or returning to dance, you are welcome and encouraged to join our adult dance program.

Adult Ballet I is a great way to improve your balance, coordination, strength and flexibility. This class includes a center warm-up, abdominal exercises, floor barre, ballet technique, stretches and movement combinations. No dance experience is necessary.

Adult II is appropriate for students with 1-2 years of previous ballet training and continues to build the student's movement, vocabulary and coordination.

Adult Ballet III, for experienced dancers to hone their technique and enjoy challenging classical ballet combinations.

Adult Modern, for students with some dance or movement experience to build strength, dynamics, and explore movement combinations.

Dress code for all Adult classes is form fitting fitness attire or ballet attire. Options for ballet attire are leotard, tights (skirt optional), white t-shirt, black tights or pants with dance belt. Ballet shoes are required for all students.
