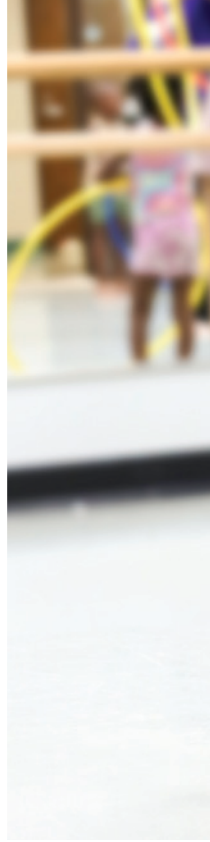

Board-certified music therapists provide a fun and supportive environment where campers can explore self-expression, build social connections, and develop new skills. Campers are grouped by age, and each day features a unique theme with interactive music-making, movement, and creative arts activities.

Priority enrollment is given to children with disabilities. A limited number of spots may be available for siblings or peers without disabilities.

## Individual Music Therapy Sessions

Music therapy addresses health-related needs throughout music. Using the science of how music affects the brain, music therapists can address a wide variety of cognitive, physical, social, or emotional needs. Music therapists implement clinical and evidence-based interventions to focus on non-musical goals. They frequently work with people who have: Autism, Down Syndrome, Parkinson's Disease, Dementia, Stroke, Traumatic Brain Injury, Cerebral Palsy, and more. Sessions may include: improvisation, songwriting, group instrument play, music and movement, and structured music listening.

### Summer String Intensive - Ages 11 - 18

Advance and sharpen your string skills in Summer String Intensive!

FSPA string faculty guide students through string orchestra rehearsals where they develop ensemble skills and advance their technique in areas such as dynamic expression, shifting, and vibrato. Students also spend time working in chamber groups for a more individualized experience.

Students with two years' experience, and students with significantly more experience, up to and including high school and Flint Youth Symphony Orchestra, will all find repertoire to engage and challenge them. The instruction is intense, but the benefits will be visible as students gain an edge in advancing skills. This is a great local and affordable alternative to overnight music camps.

#### **Prerequisites:**

Students provide their own instruments.

Students must be able to read music on the instrument they will play at camp.

Students should have a minimum of 2 years of experience in a daily school music program, completion of Suzuki book 1, 1 year of experience in the FSPA Flint Youth String Orchestra, or similar auditioned ensemble.

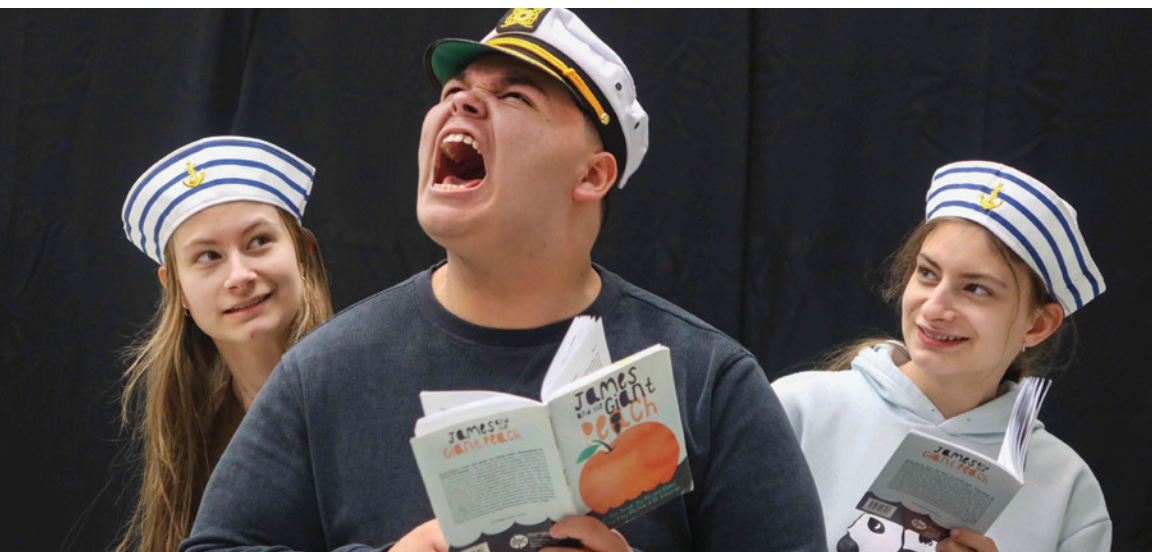
